

Milton Municipal Utilities Commission

Minutes – May 6, 2021 Meeting



Mayor Tom Canterbury called the Utilities Meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

Those present were: Mayor Canterbury, Commissioners Chittum, Miller and Meadows, Public Works Director Charlie Conard, Jessica Ramsey and Chantall Kirk. Commissioner Chastain was absent.

Commissioner Miller moved to approve the agenda. Second by Commissioner Chittum. Motion Carried.

Mayor Canterbury read the minutes from the April 2021 meeting. Commissioner Miller moved to approve the minutes. Second by Commissioner Meadows. Motion carried.

Commissioner Chittum moved to approve the bills totaling \$235,693.91, an itemized copy of which is posted in the lobby of City Hall. Second by Commissioner Miller. Motion carried.

Office Utilities Update:

Requests for leak adjustments were presented to the Board.

The Board reviewed the Monthly Water Collection Efficiency Report.

The American Rescue Plan was discussed. The first installment of the relief money is expected to be sent out in May 2021, and the second part is to be allocated in 2022. A separate bank account will need to be established to receive these deposits. It is estimated that the City will receive \$1.05 million.

Commissioner Miller moved to approve the Office Utilities Update. Second by Commissioner Chittum. Motion carried.

Thrasher Engineer Report:

Regarding the Sewer Project, Ron Flora sent a letter to Forward. She returned his call and asked if the location can be moved since it is closer to her other properties. Flora spoke with Smith and attempted to call her back but Forward did not answer. Flora will try once more to contact her this Friday. If he is unsuccessful, the Board agreed to having him begin the proceedings for condemnation so we can move forward. Smith says if all goes well then it will be 5 weeks to go to bid but permission must be given by the USDA.

Commissioner Miller moved to approve the Thrasher Engineer Report. Second by Commissioner Chittum. Motion carried.

Commissioner Miller made a motion to adjourn at 6:29 p.m. Second by Commissioner Chittum. Motion carried.
