

Milton Municipal Utilities Commission

Minutes – February 2, 2021 Meeting



Mayor Tom Canterbury called the Utilities Meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

Those present were: Mayor Canterbury, Commissioners Chittum, Chastain and Meadows, Charlie Conard, Jessica Ramsey and Susan Elliott. Commissioner Miller was absent.

Commissioner Chastain moved to approve the agenda. Second by Commissioner Chittum. Motion Carried.

Mayor Canterbury read the minutes from the January 2021 meeting. Commissioner Chastain moved to approve the minutes. Second by Commissioner Meadows. Motion carried.

Commissioner Chittum moved to approve the bills totaling \$217,091.03, an itemized copy of which is posted in the lobby of City Hall. Second by Commissioner Meadows. Motion carried.

Office Utilities Update:

Requests for leak adjustments were presented to the Board, all of which were approved.

The Board reviewed the Monthly Water Collection Efficiency Report.

Regarding the RPOC contract, Conard stated that an agreement has been reached and we are awaiting signatures from all parties. We are hopeful to have those by the next RPOC meeting.

Smith said that he has been in contact with a couple manufacturers looking into some options for upgrading the Water Plant. They will be getting back to him with pricing.

Commissioner Chastain moved to approve the Office Utilities Update. Second by Commissioner Chittum. Motion carried.

Thrasher Engineer Report:

Acquisitions have been obtained from Jim's Camping to use for the Sewer Project. Those documents are at Flora's office and should be signed this week. Calls placed to Forward, representative of Mud River Land Trust, are still unanswered and messages have not been returned. Smith says he would like to coordinate a conference call between Forward, the Corps of Engineers and himself to discuss exactly what will be happening with the property. According to Smith, if they continue to get no response from the property owner, the next step will be condemnation which will be both time consuming and costly. Smith will be drafting a letter to Forward stating that if she has not been in contact with them by a specific date, then condemnation is imminent.

Commissioner Chittum moved to approve the Thrasher Engineer Report. Second by Commissioner Chastain. Motion carried.

Commissioner Chastain made a motion to adjourn at 5:54 p.m. Second by Commissioner Chittum. Motion carried.
